## Preview of the new products by ABET LAMINATI at The International Design Biennale in Kortrijk INTERIEUR 2010 15-24 October 2010 Stand 418 / Hall 4

On the occasion of Interieur, with a fairy-tale like stand made up of cosy tables among stylized trees, ABET LAMINATI presents new important collections.

An amazing chromatic palette takes its shape from the combination between  $pRaL^{\otimes}$  SSM and Print HPL laminates.

Resulting from the wide range of shades available in the Colours series, the 6 new colours available in pRaL® have elegant soft nuances, from white to sand colour, including grey and dove grey. The new collection Abet Wood is applied on a full-relief installation, which is similar to real trees: a new generation of wood laminates which combines the natural appearance of real wood, with its warmth and shades, with the features of the laminate.

This new collection is made up of 22 different wood species: 6 in natural wood and 16 in reconstituted wood.

Tefor®, the first totally recycled and recyclable laminate, was obtained from the collection and reuse of manufacturing wastes, which have been ground up and mixed with recycled polypropylene. It is usually proposed in its natural colour, a brown nuance which is very similar to that of the packing cardboards; now it is available in a range of 8 new colours. On the occasion of the Design Biennale, a bird house has been created, using only ecological, environmentally friendly material. ABET LAMINATI adds new shades to the collection Full Colour, a self-supporting laminate. The news 2010 is Full Colour, I mm thick, with an adhesive back which allows to apply the laminate to the MDF, chipboard or plywood.

At The International Design Biennale in Kortrijk INTERIEUR 2010, ABET LAMINATI will also be present at the exhibition "Design at Work 10", where it will show the new collection Crystaline created by Konstantin Grcic in cooperation with SWAROVSKI ELEMENTS for the project "Swarovski Elements at Work". The project has previously been displayed at the Triennale in Milan during the Salone del Mobile 2010.
